Our objectives & vision

Junior Football is a great introduction to the game of football. It provides a good framework for developing ball skills, spatial awareness, team work and leadership skills. At this stage, the objective is for all the children to enjoy themselves whilst learning the skills required to play the game. Training is structured to provide a positive atmosphere for all the children while they learn and develop mentally and physically.

Risborough Rangers was started in 1971 and since then thousands of children have enjoyed their time with us. Today we are one of the largest clubs in the area with over 350 boys and girls playing regularly between the age of 5 and 16.

We aim to create a fun and purposeful environment where all players may develop to the best of their ability. To place the needs of the child first and encourage an atmosphere and environment where winning matches is neither the sole nor most important measure of success.

We are proud to have FA Charter Status and fully support the FA Respect campaign to encourage good behaviour and sportsmanship.

We want everyone to learn how to play and enjoy their football. We want to coach and play in an environment where our players want to continue to play into adult life and, if possible our senior teams. As coaches, players and parents we all have a major role to play in delivering this vision.

All coaching is by qualified volunteers who have been screened for their suitability for working with young people, they have undergone a DBS check and completed the "FA Safeguarding Children Workshop" Each age group also has a qualified FA Level 1 or Level 2 coach/manager that is also trained in First Aid. We are always on the look out for new parent helpers and coaches so if you would like to get involved (it's a lot more fun and warmer than standing on the touchline!) get in touch with your age group manager or one of the officials listed below.

The club embraces the FA's Respect codes of conduct for Players, Managers, coaches, parent volunteers and spectators and expects you to positively support them. They can all be viewed on our club website along with our welfare policy documents. Please digest them and help us install these values in your children

We allow a short free trial period for new players (Minis are free) before we ask them to be registered to the club. There is an annual signing on fee which reduces for each additional child.
